



The CJGA Putting Contest consists of 3 rounds with 4 putts per round.

Round 1

The 1st Round consists of putts from 5 feet. The first 3 putts are worth 1 point each. The 4th putt is worth 5 points but you have to get the ball to stop in between the black line and board. If the ball falls off the putting green, accidentally goes into the hole, or hits the back board you lose 5 points.

Round 2

The 2nd round consists of putts from 6 feet. The first 3 putts are worth 2 points each. The 4th putt is worth 10 points but you have to get the ball to stop in between the black line and board. If the ball falls off the putting green, accidentally goes into the hole, or hits the back board you lose 5 points.

Round 3

The 3rd round consists of putts from 7 feet. The first 3 putts are worth 3 points each. The 4th putt is worth 20 points but you have to get the ball to stop in between the black line and board. If the ball falls off the putting green, accidentally goes into the hole, or hits the back board you lose 5 points.
